## COOKIE POLICY

We use cookies to optimize and enhance your user experience on our website. If you do not wish cookies to be used, you can delete or block them through the settings of your browser. However, let us remind that such an act can prevent you from using all features of our website.

### 1. What is a cookie, and why do we use it?

Cookies are small text files stored on your device or server, by the websites you visit, through the browser you use.

The primary use cases of the cookies on our website are listed below:

- Improving the services provided to you by enhancing the function and performance of the website,
- Enhancing the website and offering new features through the website, and customizing the features in accordance with your preferences,
- Ensuring your legal and commercial security, as well as the security of the website and our Firm.

### 2. Types of cookies used on our website

Type of Cookie	Description
Session Cookies	Session cookies are temporary cookies used during the visits to our website and deleted once the browser is closed.  The basic purpose of using these cookies is to make sure our website works correctly during your visit.
Persistent Cookies	Persistent cookies are used to enhance the functions of the website, to offer a faster and improved service to the visitors, to identify you as an existing user, and to offer you special recommendations.  Thanks to persistent cookies, when you visit our website more than once, your browser checks if you have an existing cookie created by our site, and allows the offering of customized contents for you based on your previous visits, if any, to the site, thus enabling a better service for you.
Necessary Cookies	These are the cookies which should be used to enable correct operation of the website and the use of the services offered.
Functional and Analytical Cookies	These are the cookies used for remembering your preferences, enabling effective use of the website, optimization of the site in a way tailored for your needs, and containing information on how

	you use the site. Given their function, such cookies can contain personal data. For instance, the cookies used for saving your preferred language for displaying the site are functional cookies.
Tracking Cookies	Tracking cookies are the first-party and third-party cookies created during your visits to our website and third-party domains. These cookies allow the tracking of your clicking and visit history on the domains they were created by, so as to enable the matching of these records between different domains. These cookies are used for identifying and profiling the user, targeting advertising and marketing activities, and customizing content. These cookies will not be used to determine your identity, or lead decisions regarding you in person.
