



Growing International Presence at Seawork

More than a quarter of last year's exhibitors to Seawork were from overseas, with 20% from Europe and the rest from around the globe. To reflect the growing number of overseas friends and competitors booking stands or registering attendance, Seawork and Marine Civils will be welcoming National Pavilions this year.

The Dutch Pavilion, a 25m2 stand hosted by Netherlands Marine Technology, has already confirmed a number of exhibiting companies including EST-Floattech, VDL Klima, Bachmann, Bayards Marine Structures, Rotterdam Ship Repair, VABO Composites, Next Generation Shipyards and Royal Roos.
