



Visitor Terms and Conditions

Definitions

“Organiser” shall mean Mercator Media Limited (MML). “Visitor” shall mean any person or persons, firm or company, their servants or agents. Exhibition shall mean the event known as Icelandic Fisheries and Aquaculture Exhibition and Conference (IceFish).

IceFish Conferences

These Terms and conditions refer to the Exhibition only. Please refer to separate Terms and Conditions for IceFish Conferences.

Icefish Visitor Entry Badges

Visitor Entry badges purchased for IceFish are for personal use. Except as the Organisers may agree, visitors and must not re-sell or transfer (or seek to re-sell or transfer) them. A breach of this condition will entitle the Organiser to cancel the visitor badges without prior notification, refund, compensation or liability.

Visitors must register online or via the IceFish App and provide the required information to produce a Visitor Entry badge. Visitors must inform the Organiser of any change of address, contact phone number or email address. The Organiser’s preferred method of contact is email, so visitors should take care to provide a current, valid email address.

Badge printing and collection

Prior to the Exhibition visitors will receive a barcode by email. This will be used to print a Visitor Entry badge at the Registration desk on arrival at IceFish.

Cancellation Rights and Refunds

Visitor Entry badge cannot be transferred, exchanged, or refunded once purchased other than for the reasons set out in these terms and conditions.

Cancellation/Postponement of the Exhibition

The Organiser reserves the right to make alterations to the Exhibition programme, venue and timings.

Decisions to change or cancel events are the responsibility of the Organiser. The Organiser cannot guarantee to inform visitors of any change or cancellation of the Exhibition, although every effort will be made to do so. Visitors should always check that the Exhibition is going ahead at the scheduled date, time and venue.

In the unlikely event of the Exhibition being cancelled by the Organiser, a full refund will be made. All refunds must be claimed no later than 14 days after the date of cancellation. Liability will be limited to the amount of the fee paid less any bank charges incurred.

In the event of it being found necessary, for whatever reason, that the Exhibition being postponed or the dates being changed, the Organiser shall not be liable for any expenditure, damage or loss incurred by the visitor.

If an event is rescheduled, changed or moved the Organiser will give visitors the option of a Visitor Entry badge for the new date/location or requesting a refund. In the latter circumstance a refund must be claimed within 7 days of the notification of the change. Refunds will not be issued within 5 days of the event or once the event has taken place.

Refunds

If for any reason visitors are entitled to a refund, any refund will usually be paid, using the same method visitors used to buy Visitor Entry badge, within 30 days of the original date of the Exhibition.

Attending the Exhibition

The Organiser has no responsibility whatsoever for any loss or damage of any kind suffered at or in connection with the Exhibition (including loss, damage or theft any personal property at an event).

Admission to the Exhibition is subject to any terms, conditions or rules of the Organiser. If visitors breach those terms, conditions or rules then the Organiser may refuse admission or require visitors to leave the venue and visitors will not be entitled to a refund.

Amongst other things visitors will need to comply with health and safety rules and any security requirements (including security searches for the safety of those attending the Exhibition).

The Organiser will have rights to refuse admission or eject visitors in certain circumstances and these are likely to include if visitors are involved with abusive, threatening, drunken or other anti-social behaviour, or carry offensive weapons or illegal or prohibited substances or make unauthorised audio, video or photographic recordings.

Photography & Filming

For promotional purposes, there may be a professional photographer and video production taking place during the Exhibition. Visitors who do not wish to be filmed or recorded should advise the organisers by email to press@icefish.is prior to the event.

Exhibitor and Speaker's Views are their own

The Organiser cannot accept liability for advice given, or views expressed, by any exhibitor or speaker at the Exhibition or in any material provided to visitors.

Websites & Links

The Exhibition and associated Organiser websites may link to other websites and networking tools provided for the convenience of the users. The contents of these websites are maintained by their owners, for which the Organiser takes no responsibility. Neither can responsibility be taken for contents of any website linking to this website.

Privacy

Visitors completing and utilising their profile on IceFish online and allowing their Visitor Entry badge to be scanned by an exhibitor, sponsor or for a seminar session at IceFish will be providing users, exhibitors, sponsors and organisers with their personal data. Visitors consent to this personal data being used to contact them about their products or services.

Visitors also understand and agree that their personal data may be held and used by the Organiser, and any third-party hosting provider acting on its behalf, in order to run the Exhibition and for analysing visitor traffic with a view to improving the Exhibition experience for users and visitors.

General

The purchase of Visitor Entry badges and these terms and conditions (and any contractual or non-contractual matters arising in relation to these terms and conditions) are governed by English law and any disputes arising out of any transaction between the visitor and the Organiser are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English Courts.
